### SUB: AWARD LETTER FOR DBT-JRF CATEGORY-I

We are pleased to inform that you have qualified BET 2020 under Category-I and you are eligible for the award of Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) funded by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India. This award letter is being issued to you for activation of fellowship under DBT-JRF programme following your admission in a Ph.D. programme. General terms and conditions governing the DBT – JRF fellowship are given below:

- Admission to Ph.D. programme:** Fellowship is tenable at any Indian university/ institution where the selected candidate registers for Ph.D programme. Admission procedure will be as per the rules and regulations of the host university/ institution. While considering the fellowship award, scanned copy of the original documents related to the eligibility criteria and caste/category/others shall be submitted for further necessary action.
- Activation of Fellowship:** Fellowship will be activated from the date of issuance of this award letter or from the date of joining the Ph.D programme, whichever is later. Validity of this award letter will be for two years from the date of issuance of the award letter, beyond which the validity of the award letter will lapse.
- Tenure of Fellowship:** Total tenure of fellowship is for a period of five (5) years from the date of activation of fellowship. Duration of the fellowship is initially for a period of two (2) years from the date of joining. Fellowship may be extended maximum up to five (5) years depending on the satisfactory progress of the fellow and the completion of the Ph.D. programme.
- Emoluments under Fellowship:** Fellow will be designated as "DBT-JRF" with consolidated fellowship of Rs. 31,000/- per month and a contingency grant of Rs. 30,000/- per year. If the fellow has not availed institutional hostel/ residential facility, fellow will be entitled for House Rent Allowance (HRA) as per DST guidelines applicable to research fellowships.
- Release of Fellowship:** Fellowship, contingency and HRA (if applicable) will be released to the host university/institution upon timely submission of requisite documents.
- Compliance with Guidelines:** Mere issuance of this award letter and activation of the fellowship does not guarantee the emoluments under the fellowship and this award will be subject to compliance to the DBT-JRF Programme Guidelines as applicable from time to time.

Based on the result of the All India Competitive Examination for Admission to 25% Seats (100% seats of Dr. RPCAU, Pusa and ICAR-DUs) in Doctoral degree programmes of accredited Universities under ICAR-AU system [SAUs, Central Agricultural Universities, viz. CAU, Imphal, Dr. RPCAU, Pusa, 3 Central Universities (CUs) having faculty of agriculture (BHU, Varanasi, AMU, Aligarh and SASARD, Nagaland University) and the award of ICAR-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.) in Agriculture & Allied Sciences for Academic Session 2020-21, this is to inform that **you have been found eligible to register (Online) for choice filling**. Based on Online Counseling in the subject of your choice, you are likely to be recommended for admission to an accredited subject and College in an accredited University. This will, however be subject to fulfilling of the prescribed eligibility requirements as stipulated in the AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2020 Information Bulletin available at [www.icar.nta.nic.in](http://www.icar.nta.nic.in) and Online Counseling Brochure available at [www.icarexam.net](http://www.icarexam.net). This will also depend upon the availability of seats at your merit rank and category and verification of documents by the officials of admitting University at the time of counseling and your physical reporting at the finally allotted university for registration/attending the classes or as per the requirements of admitting university. Subject to meeting of prescribed eligibility criteria of UR (Unreserved) category, the SC/ST/Gen-EWS/UPS/OBC/PC candidates may be allotted seat against the UR category.

Before registering for choice filling, you must ensure that all the eligibility conditions, as specified in the AICE-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.)-2020 Information Bulletin (IB) available on NTA website ([www.icar.nta.nic.in](http://www.icar.nta.nic.in)) and online counseling brochure, are fulfilled in  *toto* including completion of the degree, OGPA/percentage marks scored in Master's Degree examination, etc. (Where OGPA is awarded, equivalence between OGPA and % marks will not be acceptable). Please note that ICAR/Universities will NOT be held responsible for denial of admission to non-eligible candidates. The candidate is advised to read the IB in detail, especially the Item 4.0 (Admission through Online Counselling) of Online Counseling Brochure of AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2020 available at ICAR website ([www.icar.org.in](http://www.icar.org.in), [www.icarexam.net](http://www.icarexam.net)) and the requirements contained therein.

Scanned images (JPEG files) of the original documents [mentioned at **Item 4.1.1 of AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2020 Online Counseling Brochure**] are required to be uploaded on the counseling portal at the time of counseling.

Candidates reporting for the admission must have Degree/Provisional Degree Certificate (PDC) of completion of Master's degree programme at the time of online verification of document by the allotted university. The candidates who do not have the Degree/PDC, have to mandatorily produce a certificate from the Registrar of the concerned university specifically indicating that ***the candidate has been awarded Final OGPA/Percentage of marks at the end of final semester/year and he/she shall be completing all the requirements including thesis submission and completion of viva-voce for the award of Masters degree before 31.12.2020 along with mentioning the likely date of issuance of PDC/Degree to the candidate.***

The candidate should note that having 4/5 (B.V.Sc.& A.H.)/6 (10+6, B.Sc. Ag.) years' UG degree is the essential requirement for admission to Master degree programmes. The candidates having passed with 3 years' UG degree programme are not eligible for admission through AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2020 except at IARI and NDRI in few courses.

In case any degree from a particular college/university is not considered for admission by an Agricultural University on account of a particular college/university being derecognized by VCI/UGC, or due to any court directives (present or future), ICAR will not be responsible for admitting students of that college/university in the Universities not willing to admit such candidates.

The candidates passed out from private agricultural colleges/universities not accredited by ICAR, even though affiliated to public funded/Govt. institutions, were notified through Information Bulletin, as not eligible to appear in AICE-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.) examination. Therefore, if any of such candidates have appeared in the examination and their scores declared by NTA, are not eligible to participate in the counseling. ICAR will not be held responsible for denying admission to such candidates by any of the accredited AU under the ICAR-AU system.

The exact title/nomenclature of the degree programme might vary from one university to another. The candidate is advised to enquire about the nomenclature of degree programme and other details from the Registrar of the concerned university [for contact details, please refer Annexure-III of the Online Counseling Brochure of AICE-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.)-2020 before registering for Choice filling /seeking admission.

Against total number of ICAR seats available for a particular degree programme in a university, not more than 40% of ICAR seats from one State would be allocated to any one university in that Subject under a particular category. While computing 40% number, mathematical method of rounding to the nearest integer would be adopted except where there is only one seat, in which case, the whole seat would be allocated. While rounding off, the number might exceed 40% to that extent.

Fellowship would be granted only when the candidate seeks admission after counselling and pursues Ph.D. degree in an AU other than the AU from where he/she has completed Bachelor's or Master's degree as indicated in the Information Bulletin and Online Counseling Brochure. The candidate is advised to go through Item 7.0 [Conditions for the award of ICAR-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.)] of the Online Counseling Brochure in this regard. The award of Junior Research Fellowship/Senior Research Fellowship [JRF/SRF(Ph.D.)] shall be governed by the rules and regulations/guidelines issued and as amended by the Council from time to time in this regard.



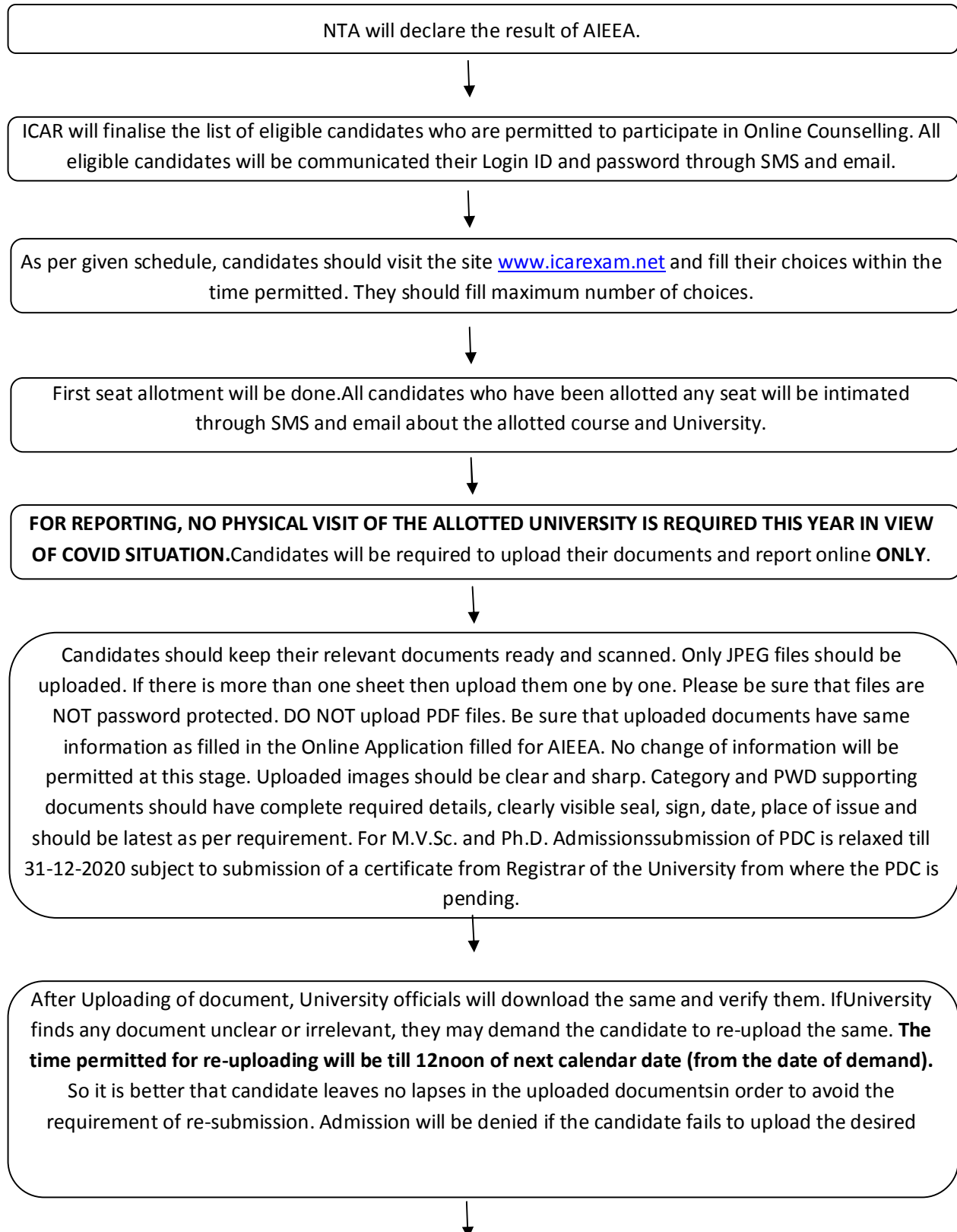

document within permitted time window. If a candidate is denied admission, then he will NOT be considered in the subsequent round.



After documents are declared “Verified” by the University, candidate has to pay “Seat Acceptance fee” of Rs 10,000. **This is to be paid by all candidates of all categories. Although this fee is non refundable but as per UGC guidelines, a candidate will get 100% refund if requested till 30-11-2020. If refund is requested till 31-12-2020 then there MAY BE a deduction of maximum of Rs 1,000. In “Upgraded” cases, the candidate will not be required to pay the “Seat Acceptance Fee” again.**



At this stage candidate will also be required to opt for “Upgradation” if he wishes to. “Upgradation” is the process to shift the candidate to his/her better choice in subsequent round of allotment (Except in last round). If an upgraded seat is allotted in the subsequent round then the candidate will have no claim left on the earlier allotted seat. So this option must be exercised carefully.



After reconciliation of Seat acceptance fee, University shall mark the candidate as “Admitted Provisionally.” Admission letter will be mailed to the candidate.



Similarly 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> round of allotment will be conducted on the same choices filled by the candidate in the beginning.



Whenever the classes begin, candidate shall carry all originals of all the documents uploaded by him/her. They will be finally verified physically. If any ambiguity is observed, the candidate may be denied admission.



Then the candidate will be required to pay the University’s admission fee (minus Rs 10,000 already paid as seat acceptance fee). The seat acceptance fee will be received by the University from ICAR.



Fellowship / Scholarship will be allotted after final admissions are completed by the University.

**NOTE:**

1. Candidates should visit the official counseling website regularly, for regular updates. Such updates will ONLY be published on this website and through NO other means.

2. Since the complete process is Online so candidates should regularly check their email and SMS. No excuse for missing any information will be entertained later.
3. Candidates should complete their choice filling / uploading / Online reporting and all online activity just when the facility begins. DO NOT wait for the last date. Verification by University, demand to resubmit some documents and fee reconciliation may take more time than expected.
