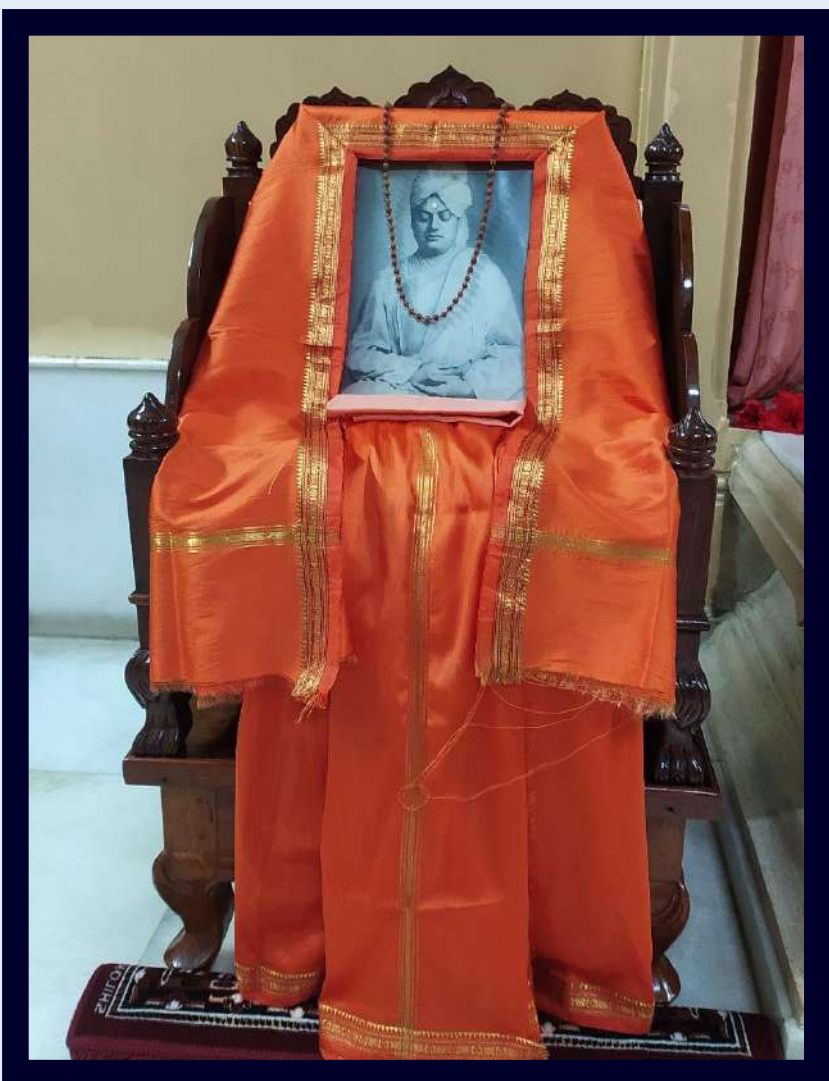

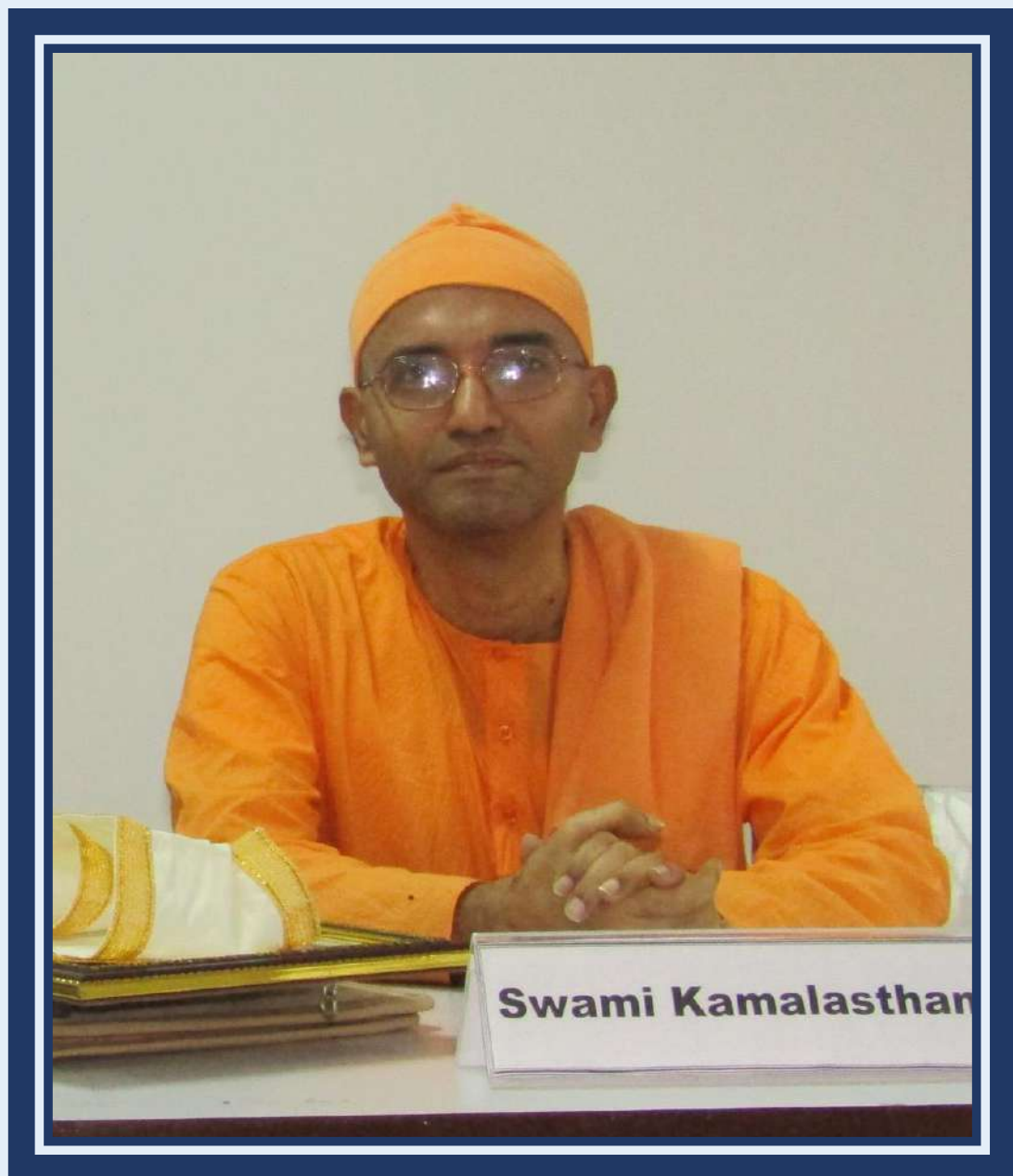

On the auspicious day of 'Saraswati Puja' (16th February, 2021) the students, ex-students and faculty members of Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Centenary College, Rahara came together to seek the blessings of the goddess of knowledge, music, art and culture. The event was celebrated with a lot of devotion and dedication by worshipping of Holy Mother Saraswati. Students were engaged for decoration, all preparations and worshipping Maa Saraswati to seek wisdom, artistic and technical skills, academic excellence and a good heart. The rituals of the worship reflect the eternal sense of devotion and traditional way of praying to the almighty for the success of an individual and an institution as a whole. The enchanting of hymns and prayers intertwined with the fragrance of the puja accessories make the whole atmosphere of the campus heavenly..

Yoga, the primordial practice of our ancestors who shaped out the great culture of our motherland; the legacy is still being continued in our modern times. Yoga has been referred a higher level of consciousness and more stable mind, not be effected by any reason what so ever, and full control of our thoughts or chitta. During high meditative state in our physical body, the brain governs all the systems stops down, there is not pleasure and nor pain. To recognize such ecstasy, we choose the basic idea of Kundalini Yoga for the decoration of our Saraswati puja Sanctorum. Old scripture of Yogasiddhantam narrates the metaphoric human body compiles into naadi and chakras. Naadi is an energy channel that flows right from the brain up until the endpoint where the internal energies are twist together in the form of Kundalini. The main focus of our; is that Sahasra chakra which is enlightened the background of Mother Saraswati, to whose existence we blessed by chitta and buddhi. By channelizing the energy flow to the mental bliss in a human body to realize chitta state of mind is known to us – Sacchidananda which is here represented by Paramahansa.

With this idea our students can decorate the surroundings by environmental sustainable material like paper etc. The ritual was graced with the presence of all the students, ex-students and faculty members and all well-wishers of the college.

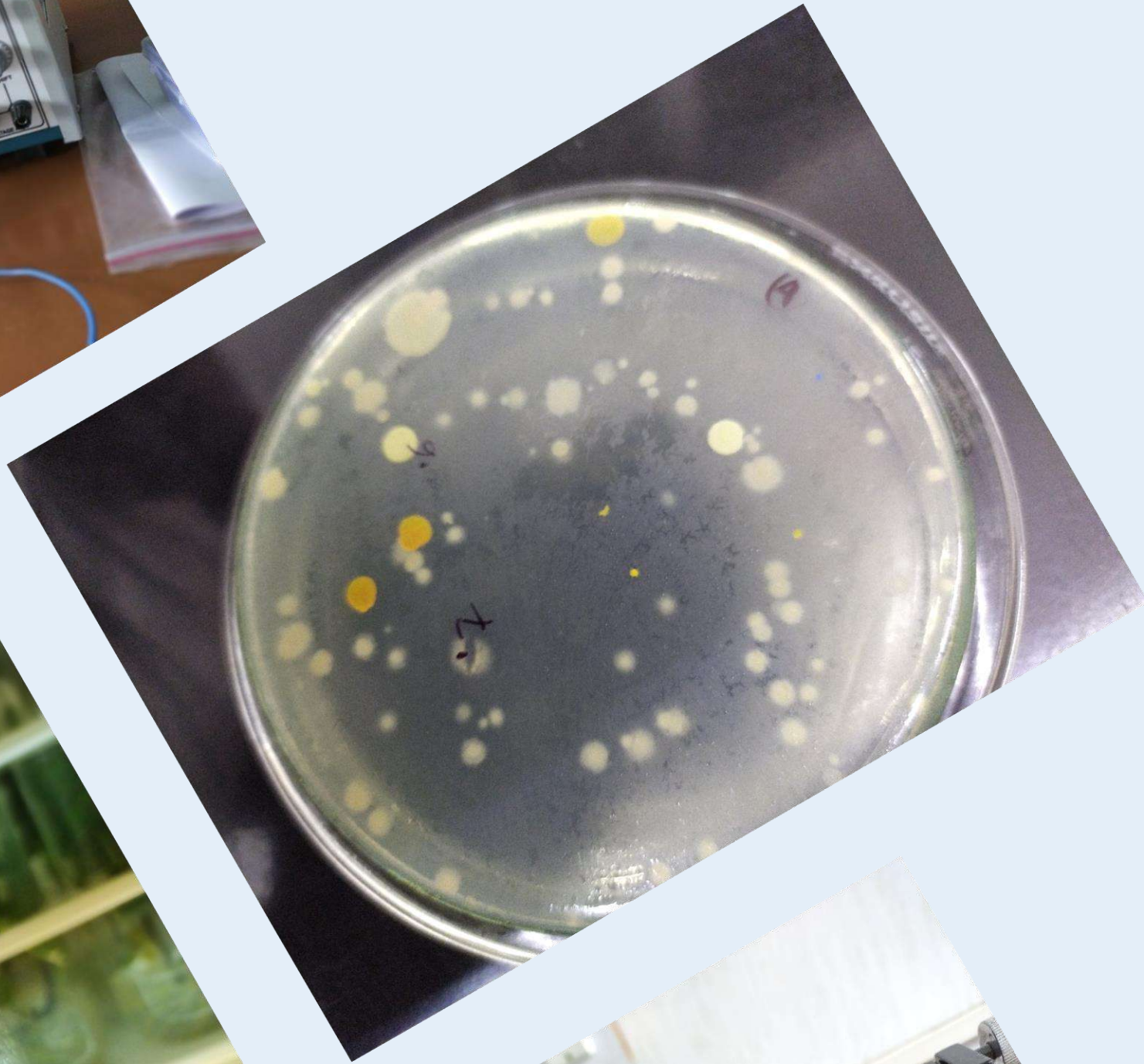

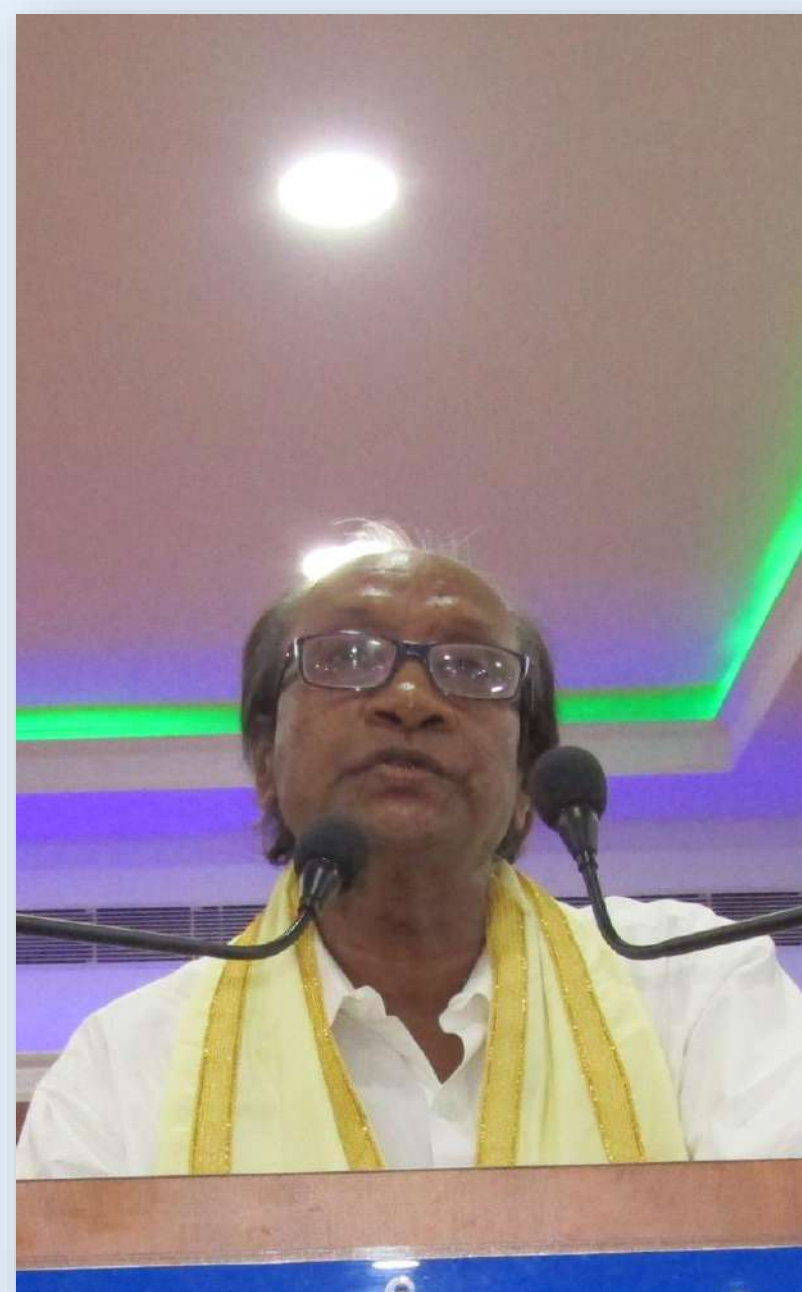


NIRF Ranking:

The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of MHRD ranked our College 15th in India and 3rd in West Bengal on 9th September, 2021.



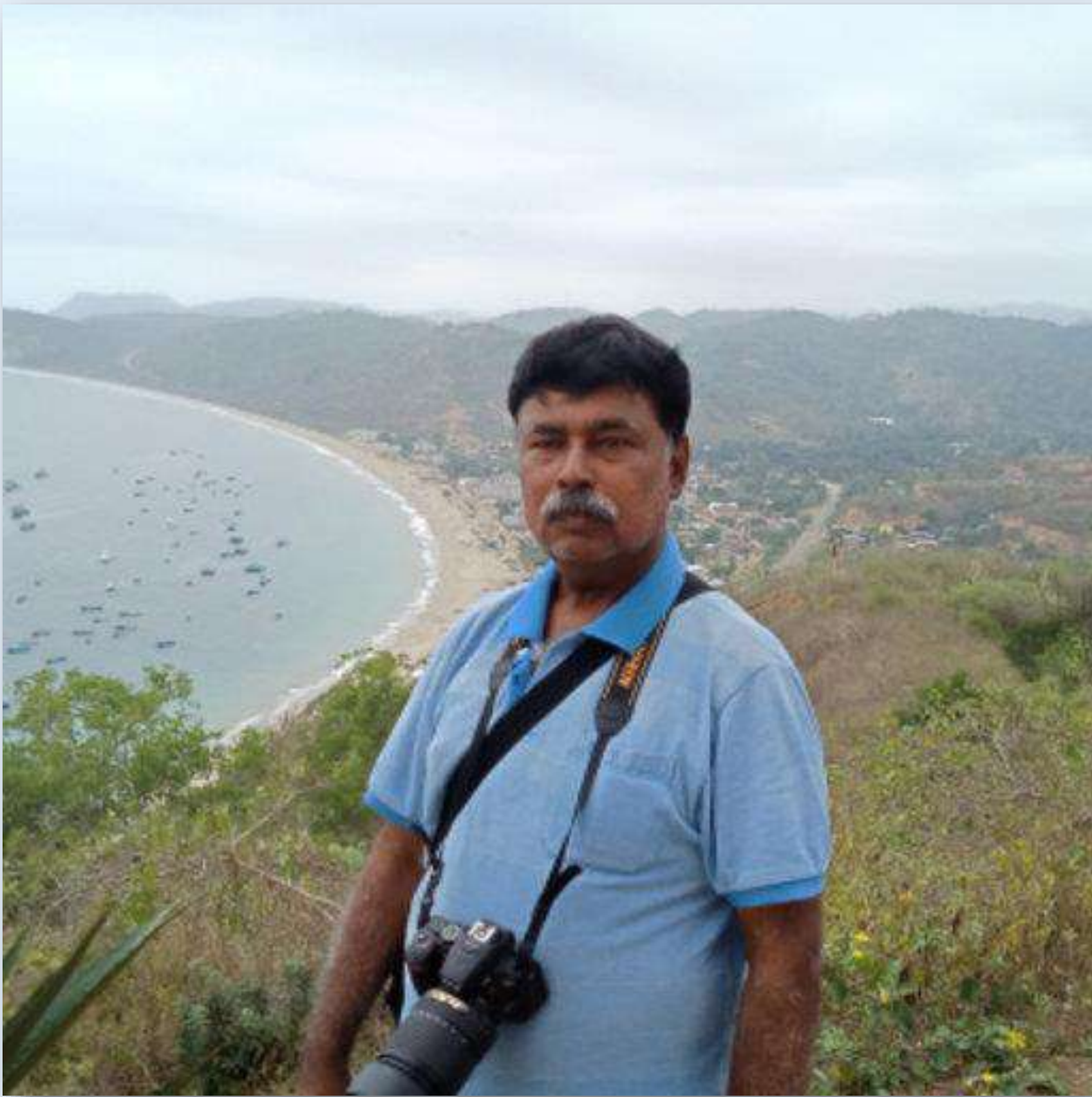
