A candidate must apply separately for each subject as per the eligibility criterion given below.

5. **ADMISSION TEST :** All candidates have to appear in admission test. The tests schedule is given below. No candidate will be allowed to take admission test without production of the Admit Card.

9. The applicant accompanied with his father / legal guardian should report for **PHYSICAL VERIFICATION of documents** punctually at the time and date as indicated in **the published list**.

A list of provisionally selected candidates based on MERIT will be displayed on the website and the selected candidates should be ready to get themselves admitted by depositing fees (through online mode), etc failing which they may lose their candidature and the same will be filled-up from the next eligible candidates.
